Marion County Accepting Credit Cards for Bail

The Marion County Clerk's office has partnered with an Indianapolis-based company to allow residents to post bail with credit or debit cards.

"We've already seen success in offering credit/debit card payments in our Child Support division and extending this service to post bail makes a lot of sense," Clerk Beth White said. "This service is a convenient, flexible way to pay bail, especially during those times when banks are closed."

To make an electronic payment, arrestees or others can call a toll-free number on site at the Arrestee Processing Center at 752 E. Market St. or the City- County Building, Room 7644. The cardholder must then present a photo ID to finalize the transaction.

"We have been offering payment solutions to criminal justice agencies across the country for more than ten years," said Dale W. Conrad, CEO of GovPayEXP, "We are eager to make this a successful partnership with the Marion County Clerk's office."

Marion County does not pay a fee to GovPayEXP; rather, the cardholder pays a fee for the service at the time of the transaction.

Most major credit cards are accepted.
