Government Payment Service, Inc. (“GPS”), dba GovPayEXP is a premier provider of payment services for consumers choosing to use credit and debit cards (“Cardholders”) as a payment method to governmental agencies that have contracted with GPS. As part of the GPS payment services provided, GPS is an authorized merchant, accepting responsibility for receiving, managing, dispersing funds, accepting liability for fraudulent use and paying all applicable merchant fees to the respective card company/association. GPS processes payments with full knowledge and authorization from Cardholders and remits a requested payment and supporting information/ reporting to the agencies. The GPS service is non exclusive to the government agency or the cardholders. The GPS agency customer has several options including using other companies simultaneously for this service and even discontinuing the service “for convenience”. The agency always offers its constituents other options to pay fees. These other options include, but are not limited to, paper checks, cash, money orders and electronic checks. The cardholder is always advised of these options. Utilizing the GPS service is simply another option for the cardholder. For this service in its entirety, including the liability for charge backs and payment of all credit and debit card fees to the card companies, GPS charges the Cardholder a fee that is determined by the amount of service provided and the risk involved.

GPS has been in operation since 1997 and has received many awards and recognition for its service. GPS complies with the requirements of its acquiring bank and each credit card association from which GPS accepts payments. Presently, GPS accepts the following cards: Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express.
